

Coming by plane

- **From Charles de Gaulle International Airport (travel time ~60 mins)**
 - Follow the signs to ground transportation and take the RER B train towards Paris (direction Massy-Palaiseau, or St-Rémy-lès-Chevreuses, or Robinson). Get off at station Gare du Nord.
 - Change to the metro line 5 in the direction Place d'Italie. Get off at station Saint- Marcel.
 - NOTE: The RER ticket can be purchased from automatic vending machines in the RER station at the airport. Just select "Single ticket to Paris from this station" option, and pay 10.30 EUR.
 - You will use the same ticket for both the RER train and the metro; do not lose it!
- **From Orly International airport (travel time ~50 mins)**
 - Take the bus ORLYBUS to Paris. Get off at the Denfert-Rochereau metro-RER station.
 - The bus comes every 10 – 20 min.
 - The bus ticket costs 8.50 EUR and can be bought from the driver.
 - At Denfert-Rochereau buy a metro ticket (1.90 EUR) from the vending machines in the station.
 - Then take metro line 6 in the direction Nation. Get off at station Chevaleret.

Coming by train

- **From Gare du Nord (travel time ~15 mins)**
 - Take metro line 5 in the direction Place d'Italie. Get off at station Saint- Marcel.
 - The ticket costs 1.90 EUR and can be purchased from automatic vending machines.

Taxi transportation:

- Uber is available in Paris, and typically priced lower than regular taxi, but significantly higher than public transportation.

Very important: ticket vending machines do not work with many non-EU credit cards. We advise you to prepare cash to buy your ticket.

Access to conference site: When you arrive at stations Saint-Marcel or Chevaleret you will have to enter the hospital yard (Hospital Pitié-Salpêtrière) in order to get to ICM (Institut du Cerveau et de la Moelle épinière), where the conference is located.
